Church affiliation was Lutheran.</p> <p><b>CHILD 1</b>    -    Niels Pedersen</p> <p>Niels owned the farm that eventually became DONNERGAARD. In 1805 there is a record that the farm was called "Donnerne". It was named after "Dunhammer" which we call "cat tails". The farm was approximately 75 acres.
